Tony Conrad in Conversation + DreaMinimalist

Sunday 15 June 2008, 15.00

Tony Conrad will discuss his radical breakthroughs in film, video, music and performance with **Branden W Joseph**, Associate Professor of Modern and Contemporary Art at Columbia University, and author of *Beyond the Dream Syndicate: Tony Conrad and the Arts after Cage* (Zone Books/MIT).

The discussion will follow a screening of *DreaMinimalist* (Marie Losier, US, 2008, 16mm, colour, 25 min), the latest in Marie Losier's ongoing series of film portraits of avant-garde directors (George and Mike Kuchar, Guy Maddin, Richard Foreman). The film offers an insightful and hilarious encounter with Conrad as he sings, dances and remembers his youth and his association with Jack Smith.
